## **Introduction**

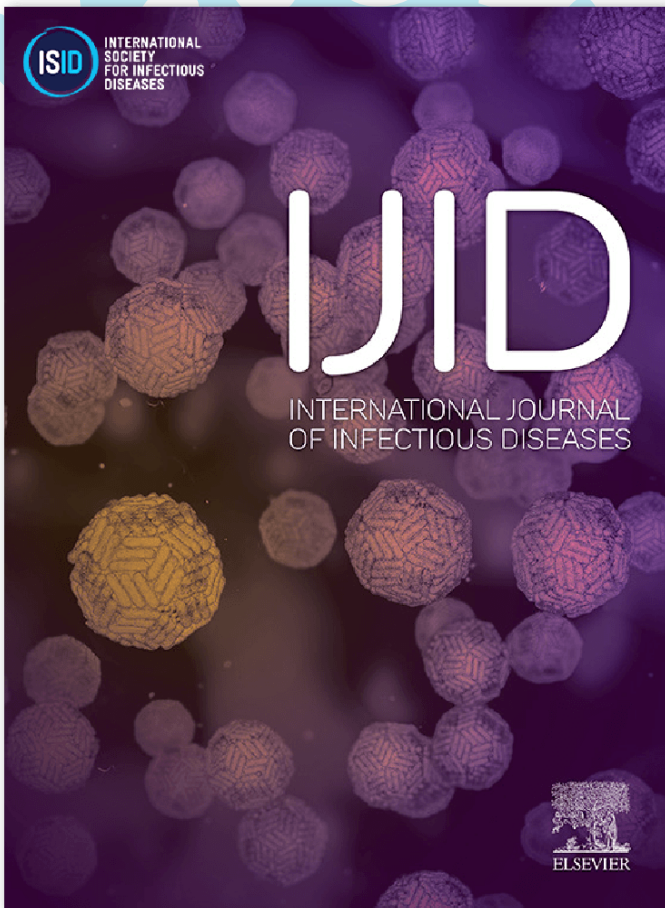

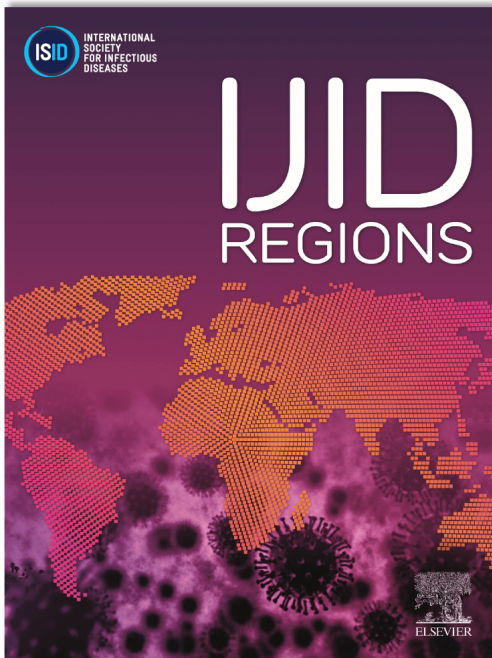

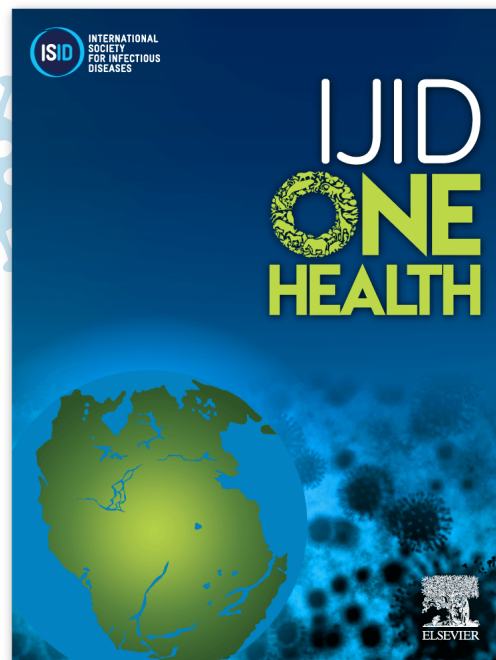
## IJID One Health
